

## Beyond The Terrace Contents list

### Introduction

The first thing to be emphasized is that the following contents list is not comprehensive. Fillers, calls for copy for the next issue and the like have been omitted as being non-substantive. In addition, some degree of tampering with the original headings has been essayed so that topics of a like character can be sensibly grouped; the best example of this tweak is with respect to 'visits' sometimes sensibly called 'visits', but also labelled 'RSPA visits' and 'outings'. Also, as compiler (and *BTT* Editor) I have discovered that headings related to news from Association members have sometimes been called 'News of Members' that can easily be confused with 'Where are they now?'; where I have succumbed to this misnomer in the newsletter, I have adjusted the heading terminology in the contents list by lumping all such news items as 'News from Members' even when slightly differently named. Yet again where there are references in the contents list to the reports of the deaths of former staff members (and indeed of Fellows who have featured in the pages of *BTT*), the contents list simply gives the name of our former colleague (or the former FRS) followed by '- deceased'.
